

SUBSCRIBER AGREEMENT for McGraw-Hill AccessScience

Missouri Library Network Corporation will include

_____ Library ("member") in its contract with McGraw-Hill to allow access to the McGraw-Hill Service known as AccessScience under the terms and conditions specified herein. The License Agreement represents the entire agreement for access to and use of the SERVICE. SUBSCRIBER agrees to abide by the information provider terms and conditions, as revised from time to time, as if same were fully set forth herein.

1. This Agreement is dependent upon the continued license between SOLINET and McGraw-Hill to make available the SERVICE referenced above. Should this license expire, SOLINET will notify member prior to the expiration so that member can make other arrangements for access.
2. Member agrees to access and use the AccessScience SERVICE in accordance with the attached License Agreement. The SUBSCRIBER will exercise reasonable good faith efforts to inform Authorized Users of restrictions on use of the SERVICE; however, the Subscriber shall not be liable for the actions of the individual Authorized Users who act without the knowledge and consent of the SUBSCRIBERS.
3. Member agrees to pay _Missouri Library Network Corporation fees as invoiced. All charges shall be due thirty (30) days from the date of the invoice reflecting such changes.
4. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Missouri.

This Agreement shall take effect upon the latest date of execution below by duly authorized representatives of the library and shall automatically renew on the first day of July 2007, except as otherwise provided by written notification from MLNC to the member, or from the member to MLNC. Service will commence on the first day of the following month of the received signed sub-agreement provided it is received no later than fifteen (15) days prior to the requested start date by the SUBSCRIBER.

This Agreement is valid and enforceable only if sufficient funds are made available to the state institutions by their respective state legislatures for the purpose of this program. It is mutually agreed that if the state legislature does not appropriate funds for the program, this Agreement shall be terminated or amended to reflect any reduction of funds. The decision to continue with the Agreement must be made no later than thirty (30) days after the new fiscal year affected by the legislature funding.

License Agreement (“License”)
The McGraw-Hill Companies, Inc. (“McGraw-Hill”)**

Definitions: As used in this License, the following terms have the designated meanings:

“**AccessScience**” refers to the McGraw-Hill online product [AccessScience@McGraw-Hill](#) and all Web pages contained therein as updated or revised from time to time while this License is in effect.

Subscriber shall be responsible for ensuring that any Users accessing AccessScience are notified of, and abide by, the terms of this License.

2. **Authorized Use of AccessScience Owned Content.** All of the AccessScience Owned Content is either the property of McGraw-Hill or is licensed to McGraw-Hill and is protected by copyright and other intellectual property laws. Subscriber shall honor all reasonable requests by McGraw-Hill to protect McGraw-Hill’s proprietary interests in AccessScience. During the term of this License, McGraw-Hill hereby grants to Subscriber and its Users a non-exclusive, non-transferable license to access and use AccessScience for the agreed upon fees and under the terms described in this License. Except for the limited rights given to Subscriber herein, all rights in AccessScience are reserved by McGraw-Hill.

3. **Use Restrictions.** With the exception of certain AccessScience Owned Content licensed to McGraw-Hill, Users may print out for such User’s own research or study only a limited number of articles from AccessScience. a. McGraw-Hill also has the right to terminate this License if it does not receive payment for it.
